- Uploading the certificates to the marketing drive and make sure the documents are up to date.
- Samples the packaging components and the raw materials as per the sampling plan.
- Test the sampled materials as per the specifications.
- Trained to sample the cannabis bulk for retains and for testing as required.
- Preparing all the required documents for release of the materials.
- Ensure all required documents are provided by the vendors and they are most up to date.
- Notify any problem or alert regarding packaging or raw material to Area manager and QA manager.
- Batch record review at real time, ensuring corrections are being completed.
- QA overview of activities on the floor.
- Assist with Operation deviation investigation.
- Support in improving and implementation of processes in Operation.
- Other responsibilities as assigned by the QAP.
